## This funding will be used to

- Achieve 80% of Prep students above the Regional Benchmark at Progress for Meaning (PM) level 8
- Achieve 75% of Year 1 students above the Regional Benchmark at PM level 16
- Achieve 75% of Year 2 students above the Regional Benchmark at PM level 22
- Achieve 80% of Year 3 students above the Regional Benchmark at PM level 26
- Achieve 80% of Year 4 students above the Regional Benchmark at PM level 28
- Achieve 80% of Year 5 students above the Regional Benchmark at PM level 30
- Achieve 90% of Year 6 students above the Regional Benchmark at PM level 30+
- All students on Individual Curriculum Plans (ICPs) will improve in their reading throughout the year.

## Our initiatives include


- Employment of additional teachers to focus on staff capability development by provide coaching, mentoring, feedback and pedagogical development in Explicit Instruction.
- Employment of additional teacher aide to support the sharp and narrow focus on reading improvement.
- Employment of additional Speech Language Pathologist to support oral language development in the early years as identified in the Australian Early Developmental Census data
- An explicit focus on Reading pedagogies, school-wide strategies, benchmark attainment and the achievement of goals and targets.
- Participation of all staff in the Reading Centre to enhance pedagogical practices school-wide.
- Upskilling staff in the use of targeted evidence based programs – Minilit.

Employment of addition staff 3.3 Full Time Equivalent (FTE) to provide teachers with 1-1 coaching, collegial team planning and mentoring sessions on a fortnightly basis	\$272,121
Employment of additional Teacher Aides (1 FTE) to support reading improvement	\$52,349
Employment of additional Speech Language Pathologist (0.2 FTE) to support oral language development in the early years	\$15,292
